We, the undersigned, being natural persons over the age of nineteen (19) years, desiring to form a nonprofit corporation pursuant to AS 10.20.005, et seq., do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation ("Association" herein) is COLLEGE SQUARE CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

- 1. The specific and primary purposes are to provide for maintenance, preservation and architectural control of a condominium project on real property located in the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska, known as College Square Condominiums and the structures and improvements thereon.
 - 2. The general purposes and powers are:
- (a) To promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents within said real property.
