

#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

We, the undersigned, being natural persons over the age of nineteen (19) years, desiring to form a nonprofit comporation pursuant to AS 10.20.005, et seq., do hereby certify as follows:

#### ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation ("Association" herein) is Hampton Place Condominium.

### ARTICLE 31

The purposes for which the corporation is formed and as follows:

- provide for maintenance, premorvation and architectural control of a condominium project on real property located in the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska, known as Hampton place Condominium, and the structures and improvements thereon.
  - 2. The denoral purposes and oswern are:
- (a) To promote the health, suffery and  $m^{1/2}$  with raid weal property.
- (b) To exercise all of the powers and privateges and to perform all of the duties and obligations of the Association arising from the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, Reservation of Covenants and Condominium Plan applicable to the researchy described above ("Declaration").
- (c) To fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by lawful means, all charges or assensivents pursuant to the terms of the Declaration; to pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Association, including all linesses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed assigns the areaerty of the Association.

- (d) To have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the nonprofit corporation law of the State of Alaska by law may now or hereafter have or exercise.
- (e) To act in the capacity of principal, agent, joint venturer, partner or otherwise.

The foregoing statements of purposes shall be construed as a statement both of purposes and of powers, and purposes and powers in each clause shall not be limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms or provisions of any other clause, but shall be broadly construed as independent purposes and powers. Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purposes and powers, the Association shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of the Association.

#### ARTICLE (TI

The duration of the Association shall be perpe-

#### ARTICLE IV

The Association shall be a nonprofit comporation, without shares of stock.

#### ARPTOLE V

The authorized number and qualifications of members of the Association, the different classes of members of it any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability to dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the Bylaws and Declaration.

#### ARTICLE VI

The initial registered office of the corporation shall be located at 7025 Madelyn Way, Anchorage, Alaska.

#### ARTICLE VII

The initial registered agent of the corporation shall be Ray Apoleby, whose business address is 7025 Madelyn Way, Anchorage, Alaska.

# ARTICLE VILI

The initial Board of Directors shall consist of three persons, and said number may be changed by a duly adopted amendment to the Bylaws, except that in no event may the number of Directors be less than three.
