NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT a reasonable fee shall be established for the preparation of a Resale Certificate and/or an update to a Resale Certificate; the payment of said fee shall be made from the assessment reserve fund and become a charge against the particular unit owner and his condominium unit;

and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Agent shall receive said funds on behalf of the Association from the unit owner or his agent prior to the issuance of said Resale Certificate.
